ON JANUARY 28TH WVU STUDENT ARTHUR BAGENDA'S BODY WAS FOUND ON THE RAIL TRAIL. BAGENDA WAS 19 YEARS OLD AND STUDYING PSYCHOLOGY AT WVU. AUTHORITIES BELIEVE THERE WAS NO FOUL PLAY ASSOCIATED WITH HIS DEATH. HOWEVER, WITH AN INCIDENT LIKE THIS SOME ARE QUESTIONING IF IT'S A GOOD IDEA TO USE THE TRAILS ALONE.

"I've come down here once by myself but I made sure I had protection on me like pepper spray or something like that."

STAR CITY POLICE CHIEF VIC PROPST HAS SOME TIPS ON HOW TO STAY SAFE WHILE USING THE TRAILS IN MORGANTOWN.

"I would recommend if you do go out after dark, travel in pairs. Always have a

cell phone handy for emergencies. And if you see it call it in, if you see anything at all that seems out of place or out of the ordinary call it in.”

“The Star City police department is already taking the initiative to make these trails safer. They tell me they are looking to acquire a four-wheeler for patrols on the trails in the morning, evening and at night.”

CHIEF PROPST ALSO TOLD ME THAT OFFICERS DO PATROLS THE TRAILS ON EVERY SHIFT. HE GOES ON TO SAY THAT EVENTS LIKE THIS ARE FEW AND FAR BETWEEN

“With our limited manpower, it limits what we can do. But, we do have officers that are physically fit and they do try to get on the trails as much as possible.

WE CALLED THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO SEE IF A CAUSE OF DEATH HAS YET BEEN FOUND. THEY ARE STILL WAITING ON THE AUTOPSY REPORT.

THE UNIVERSITY HAS ALSO REACHED OUT TO ARTHUR’S ROOMMATES. FREE COUNSELING IS AVAILABLE THROUGH THE CARRUTH CENTER AT 3-0-4-2-9-3-4-4-3-1. ANYONE WITH

INFORMATION ABOUT THE DEATH IS ASKED TO CONTACT THE MORGANTOWN POLICE DEPARTMENT. THE NUMBER IS AT THE BOTTOM OF YOUR SCREEN. C-J BACK TO YOU AT THE WATERFRONT

Place and call it Seneca Hall, and create a residence hall out of that?"

"Living in Seneca hall will cost more than \$4,000 a semester. But the demand for things like private bedrooms, kitchens and personal bathrooms played a large part in the decision to close Arnold. Although, one current student told me the absence of low-cost housing in the downtown area that's the most concerning."

"It's not fair for students to have the option to live here for a lower cost compared to somewhere else. People want to live right here downtown. That's where classes are at. It's where the nightlife, social life and all that good stuff is at."

OF THE NINE HOUSING OPTIONS, ONLY BOREMAN, DADDISMAN AND TOWERS AVERAGE UNDER THREE GRAND A SEMESTER. YET FARRIS DEFENDS THE SCHOOL'S DECISION SAYING WVU WOULDN'T BE CLOSING ARNOLD UNLESS THEY WEREN'T ALREADY SATISFIED WITH THE OVERALL NUMBER OF AFFORDABLE HOUSING OPTIONS.
