SO HOW DO YOU DECIPHER
 FACT FROM FICTION?

“There are a few ways to determine if
 a news story is fake or real. First,
 check the source. Check to see if
 well-known news outlets are talking
 about the story such as NBC News,
 ABC News, or CNN. Next, fact
 check, literally. The website
factchecker.org gets paid to verify
 fake news stories.”

DUE TO THE CONCERNS ABOUT

 FACEBOOK AND
 GOOGLE ANNOUNCED THAT
 THEY WOULD COMBAT FAKE

they are very hungry for self-improvement and learning and an imaginative escape from the tough conditions they live in.”

VOLUNTEERS RESPOND TO LETTERS FROM PRISONERS BY GATHERING BOOKS THAT MATCH THEIR INDIVIDUAL REQUESTS, WRAPPING THEM UP, AND MAILING THEM OUT FREE OF CHARGE. THEY RESPOND TO ABOUT 80 LETTERS EACH WEEK.

“The organization receives requests for a wide range of reading material ranging from science fiction novels to self-help books. But, they say their most requested title is by far the dictionary.”

AND NEARLY 690,000 PEOPLE WALK OUT OF PRISON EACH YEAR. WITH SEVERAL MILLION MORE LEAVING LOCAL JAILS. DELIA TRICKETT TEACHES RE-ENTRY CLASSES TO PRISONERS TO HELP THEM AVOID REOFFENDING.

“Being able to have that education while inside helps to empower them. It gives them better knowledge of not just laws but what’s out there.”
