AN INVESTIGATION BY NPR FOUND THAT THE RATE OF BLACK LUNG AMONG MINERS MAY BE TEN TIMES HIGHER THAN PREVIOUSLY EXPECTED. AND NOW LAWMAKERS ARE ASKING THAT MORE FEDERAL FUNDS BE SENT TO BLACK LUNG CLINICS TO HELP IMPROVE TESTING EQUIPMENT AND OVERALL AID FOR VICTIMS.

“So this breathalyzer is one of the best ways doctors can tell who has black lung and who doesn’t. You take the test a few times and it gives you a read. My read says I’ve got an average lung capacity ratio of about eighty-eight percent. It’s when that number falls below seventy-five percent that things gets a little dicey for miners. And that’s a number healthcare professionals say they’ve seen an increase of...over the past few years.”

“I don’t know if it’s because coal miners are working longer hours, more days or if the patients I’m seeing are just retired miners coming here for the first time. But yes I’m seeing an increase.”

“Most people just don’t care. They’re just concerned about their own thing. They don’t care about some hillbilly in West Virginia with black lung. As far as Trump I’m one hundred percent for the man. I hope
