"TRIP" IS A NATIONAL TRANSPORTATION RESEARCH GROUP... THAT FOUND DRIVERS IN MORGANTOWN PAY ALMOST FIFTEEN HUNDRED DOLLARS FOR VEHICLE REPAIRS FROM POOR ROAD CONDITIONS AND POTHOLES LIKE THE ONES YOU SEE HERE.

"Potholes will be more extreme on roads like this...if the winter temperatures fluctuate above and below freezing marks...causing craters such as this that can be as wide as three feet and as deep as four inches."

"I've been driving down here for three years and hitting the big potholes take a toll on your tires. My Dad doesn't appreciate me going home and asking for tires."

BEFORE THE USER FEE PASSED...THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR PAVING WAS AROUND FIVE-HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS. BUT WITH THE EXTRA CASH FLOW THE PROJECT IS EXPECTED TO COST TWO AND A HALF MILLION DOLLARS, AND COVER MORE THAN 10 MILES OF ROADS IN THE MORGANTOWN AREA.
